On The Cover

Strength, Sophistication and Style

Richmond Yacht's six-acre yard in Richmond, British Columbia, contains a 70,000-square-foot state-of-the-art facility under cover and has the capacity to simultaneously build four composite yachts from 120 feet to 155 feet in length.

North America's premier custom megayacht builder arrives at this year's Fort Lauderdale International Boat Show with a new 142-foot tri-deck motor yacht, *Richmond Lady*.

The yard's one-of-a-kind Hull #5 represents a new face for the Canadian firm. "Our custom builds will be the main focus of our presence this year, with the spotlight on this new vessel," says director of marketing Deborah Carr-Ganoe. The company has also added another respected naval architect to its design team, Ben Dodarell, whose previous engagements include tenure at Broward Yachts and Hargrave as design head.

Launched on September 6, *Richmond Lady* will be easily recognized. Built to A.B.S. class and conforming to M.C.A. code, its 270 tons of displacement are powered by twin Caterpillar 1800s with a top speed of nineteen knots and a comfortable cruising speed of sixteen knots.

"It's the profile that is different and gives the yacht a new visual identity," adds Carr-Ganoe. "The superstructure, which features styling by Ward Setzer, has been updated by our project manager Alan Fleet, whom has given it a stronger profile and more interior space on the bridge deck." The redesigned pilot house windshield also provides better visibility for the crew, along with the addition of a chart table and GMDSS radio deck.

Richmond Lady is finished throughout in African mahogany and slab marble, featuring edge detailing and inlay, and has replaced tile throughout the boat. A built-in foam- and power-wash system includes four remote stations at convenient locations around the vessel. "This will reduce the wash down time by half and facilitate removing the salt from the yacht with minimal effort," says Keith Kiselback, vice president of operations.

Other features of the yacht that make it attractive for charter as well as private use have been retained. They include a spacious galley, an inviting flybridge/spa deck with a seven-foot by eight-foot Jacuzzi, and well-considered traffic patterns.

Note: As the "vertical bridge" styling change is offered as an option, Hull #6, scheduled to launch in March 2009, can still be built with either the traditional raked windshield or the new vertical look. The choice will be the owner's option.

Master Stateroom

The on-deck master suite is designed with elegance and comfort in mind. At the entrance, you will find a built-in desk and bookshelf/office area with a computer center and a Sub-Zero two-drawer refreshment center. As you walk into the master stateroom, the king-size bed is set in the center of the room with a lounge starboard side and a dresser with a vanity on port. A full entertainment system is hidden in cabinetry opposite the bed. As you enter the stateroom, on the port side, next to the vanity, you will find a large walk-in cedar-lined closet with plenty of storage and drawers. Forward of the bed are his-and-her bathrooms, his with a dual-head shower and steamer, hers with a large Jacuzzi tub. A fog mirror between the baths provides privacy. Gorgeous pleated shades are the window treatments of choice and custom slab marble and granite flooring and counter tops add a taste of elegance.
